The methodology enables addressing common risks for confounding bias, distinguishing between structural forms of sexual minority stigma (e.g., discriminatory legislation, lack of protective policies, negative population attitudes) across various levels of society (e.g., state/county/district), and examining their effects on mental health across the life course, as coproduced within a socioecological system of oppression.
